#### **Business and Associations**

Enterprises, institutions, organizations and institutions that hire qualified workers and / or provide professional and practical training of applicants for vocational education. Professional associations, employers, their organizations and associations, trade unions and associations

## Core Problems



#### Legislation

Outdated legal and regulatory framework



#### **Funding**

Reordering of funding mechanism of VET schools



#### **State Standards**

Outdated list of professions of skilled workers, state standards on specific working professionals, the lack of professional standards, developed on the basis of competence approach



#### **Imbalance**

Imperfect mechanism of balance of supply of training of skilled workers and demand at the national and regional labor markets

## Key Challengers



#### **Prestige**

Low prestige and funding of VET teaching staff



#### **Accreditation Centers**

Absence of Independent centers for learning outcomes assessment



#### "Brain Drain"

VET teaching staff moves to Higher Education Institutions and to real sector



#### **State Support**

Low level of State Support of Vocational Schools moved from the temporary occupied territories



#### **◯** Low Qualifications

Filling vacancies of VET teaching staff by graduates without appropriate professional qualifications



#### **Migration**

Work migration of youth to developed countries

## Key Challengers



#### Rehabilitation

Lack of effective vocational rehabilitation of participants ATO



#### **Integrated Professions**

Imperfect mechanism of consolidation and the introduction of new working professions



#### **National Qualification Framework**

The lack of state support and funding of implementation of the national qualifications framework, creation of professional standards on the basis of international standards



#### Duplication

Duplication of functions among VET Schools and Higher Education Institutions



#### **E-environment**

Absence of unified electronic educational environment


