



### **Round table “Applied learning in the field of VET” in the Kyiv National Economic University named after Vadym Hetman**

On June 06, 2018, the round table was held by the project team of the Kyiv National Economic University named after Vadym Hetman in order to disseminate the results of the Erasmus + project “Improving teacher education for applied learning in the field of VET (ITE-VET)”.

The round table “Applied learning in the field of VET” was attended by more than 120 participants: teachers of vocational education, teachers of Economics and Business from colleges, vocational schools, secondary schools, colleagues from KNEU, Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv, National Transport University, National Pedagogical Drahomanov University, employees of research institutions.

In his welcoming speech, the rector of KNEU, Dmytro Lukianenko, spoke about the model of management of the business university, which is KNEU today, as well as components of the successful teaching a modern specialist.

Svitlana Tsymbaliuk, the dean of the Faculty of Personnel Management, Sociology and Psychology, presented the Erasmus + project “Improving teacher education for applied learning in the field of VET” (ITE-VET).

The results of the employers’ survey held with the aim to determine competences of college graduates were acquainted by Tetiana Shkoda, the associate professor of the Department of Personnel Management and Labor Economics.

Maryna Artiushyna, the acting head of the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology, presented the main results of the project concerning the modernization of study plan for the training of VET teachers.

Oksana Sarkisova, the associate professor of the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology, characterized the directions for strengthening the practical training future VET teachers and as well handed in certificates of acknowledgement to the educational institutions for organizing the pedagogical practice for students of the specialty “Vocational education (Economics)”.

Larysa Korvat, the deputy head of the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology, presented a new specialization “Economic and Business Education”.

Larysa Yancharska, the associate professor of the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology, told about the experience of teacher training at the University of Valencia.

Anna Romanova, the deputy director for scientific work of the Institute of Vocational Education of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, made the presentation “Status and prospects of applied learning VET teachers”.

Olga Chabaniuk, the director of the Center for Educational Work and Social Adaptation of KNEU students, shared the useful experience of establishing an Ombudsman’s Office by implementing the student’s rights commissioner (within the Erasmus + project AESOP).

Alla Vasylyk, deputy head of the Department of Personnel Management and Labor Economics, shared the experience of developing entrepreneurial competencies among students (within the Tempus project BUSEEG-RU-UA).

The representative of the National Erasmus+ office in Ukraine Kateryna Zhdanova highly evaluated the project outcomes and the work of the KNEU team, emphasized the importance of conducting such events in order to disseminate information about the project and implement its results in other educational institutions.



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Within the round table, the participants had the opportunity to improve their qualification and attend the master classes of the KNEU teachers. Head of the Department of Professional Guidance, Development of Entrepreneurship and Leadership, director of LLC “Intellectual Technologies Company” Vitaliy Pazdriy held the master class “Development of entrepreneurial competences in the educational process”.

The associate Professor of the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology Yulia Matvienko together with the students of the specialty “Vocational Education (Economics)” held the master class “Creativity and Development of Creative Abilities”.

Associate Professor Larisa Yancharskaya and senior lecturer Victoria Syrovatko told about the modern training technologies in teaching Economics.

The round table completed the pedagogical flashmob, and each participant received a certificate.
