- International cooperation in education.

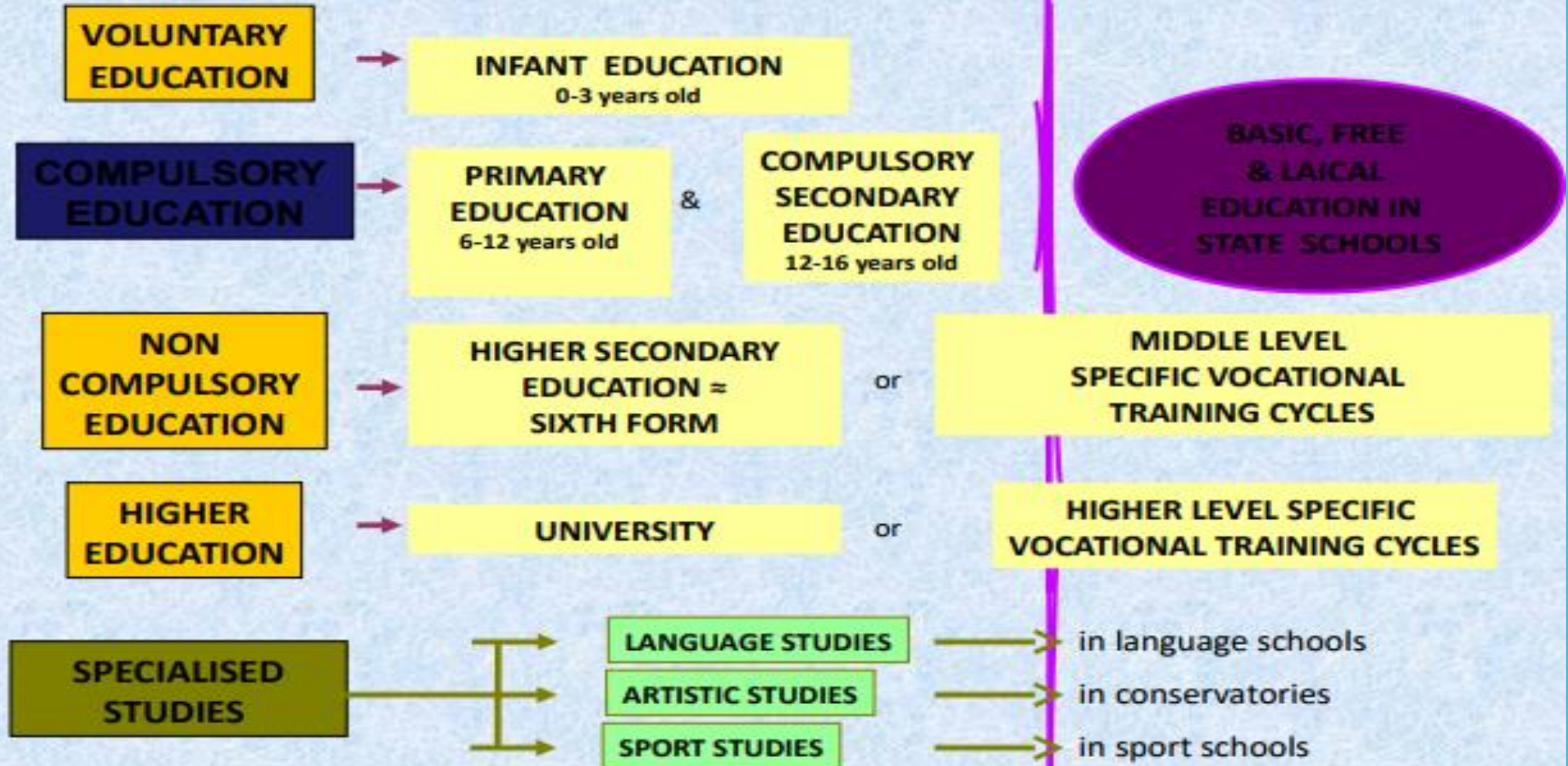
Autonomous regions

EDUCATIONAL LEVELS IN SPAIN

Pre-Scholar education	3-6 years	-
Primary education	6-12 years	the 3d grade – State examination
		the 6th grade – State examination
Secondary (I level) education	12-15 years	the 9th grade - Selection of specialization (exact sciences / human sciences)
Secondary (II level) education	15-16 years	the 10th grade - State Examination for GCSE (General Certificate of Secondary Education).
Vocational education	-	Entrance exam
Higher education	-	Entrance exam

Also, we discussed the master's degree program at the University of Valencia in the direction of "Social Education". We found out that the Master's study plan "Social Education" includes 60 credits. The subjects are:

- Personnel training and development (psychology)
- Society, Family and Education (Sociology)
- Educational contexts and processes (pedagogy)
- Addition to a disciplinary form
- Teaching innovation and learning
- Begin to educational research
- Study and teaching of the subject.



VISIT TO FOREM-PV PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION CENTER

- The FOREM-PV Educational Center in Valencia is the head office of the network of vocational training centers in the province of Valencia, Spain. The main source of funding for educational programs taught at the center is the funds of the local budget of Valencia and the general state budget of Spain. FOREM-PV deals with the following areas of educational services:
 - Professional orientation
 - Courses of professional technical qualification for immigrants
 - Courses of vocational education and qualifications for the unemployed
 - Courses for advanced training in a number of areas
 - School for people of retirement age
 - The course of social adaptation and internal communication for health workers
 - Foreign language courses for adults.

- **The aim** is to provide our adult students with more ways to improve their knowledge and skills, facilitate their personal development and boost their employment prospects.

WORK AT THE LIBRARY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VALENCIA



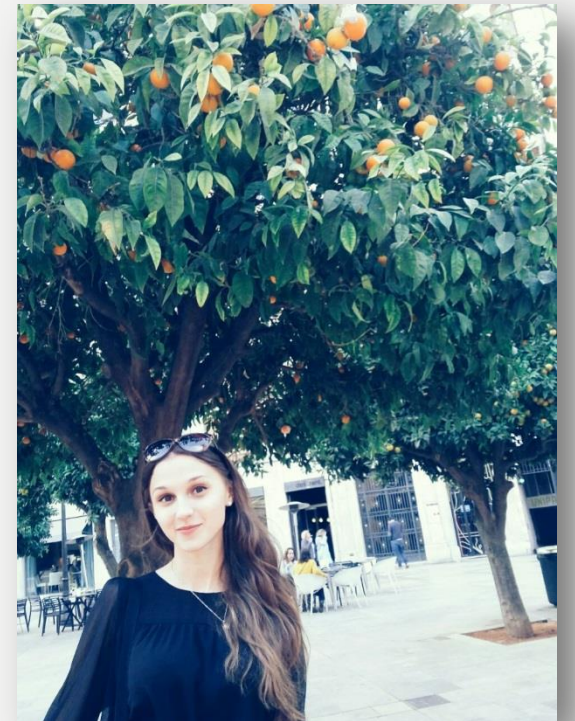
