You want to apply your acquired knowledge from your studies in practice? Go for the DSP!


- 6 ECTS in the SSA module


- cooperation between SEDS program and cyberLAGO


It is all about networking!

Admission requirements

We are looking for students with different backgrounds (e.g. social science, computer science, etc.) and a strong interest in quantitative methods and empirical research!

- above average B.A. degree
- minimum three B.A. courses that cover at least two focus areas (social-scientific methods, computer science, mathematics, statistics)
- evidence of good English skills (TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge Certificate OR for students from UKN → min. 30 ECTS BA courses taught in English)
- CV and motivation letter
- two letters of recommendation from university teachers
- results of the GRE test desirable but not mandatory




